UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. On a recommendation of the Ordinance Committee, consider approval of Ordinance 2026-01 relating to the reduction of Planning Commission from 7 to 5 members.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Consider approval of Stone Bid.
2. Consider approval for the Iron Man Competition to run through Mill Hall Borough on Sunday, June 14, 2026. Beech Creek Avenue and Water Street will be utilized. Mill Hall Borough Police Department to provide traffic control.
3. Consider approval for Mill Hall Elementary School to use the Mill Hall Community Park for their end of the year school field trip on May 28 with a June 2 rain date. They will need to reserve all the pavilions that day. No charge.
4. Consider approval to allow KCSD Central Mountain Baseball use of the large baseball field for practice and games from March 2026 through June 2026.
5. Consider approval to adopt Resolution 2026-08 recognizing April 2026 as Pennsylvania 811 Safe Digging Month.
6. Consider approval to write a letter of support for the proposed Clinton County pedestrian safety improvement project along High Street in the Borough of Flemington, near the municipal connection with Bald Eagle Township.
7. On a recommendation of the Sewer/Highway Committee, put the sale of the pump station in the newspaper and on Municibid via Resolution 2026-09.
8. On a recommendation of the Sewer/Highway Committee, Borough will not maintain the sidewalk on the PennDot owned bridge between Main and Water Streets.
9. Consider approval to change the Capital Reserve Budget line item name from Fire Equipment to Emergency Services Equipment/Maintenance.
10. On a recommendation by the Personnel Committee, consider approval to update the Mill Hall Borough Personnel Policy in relation to emergency call outs and paid time off.

11. On a recommendation by the Personnel Committee, consider approval to pay Code Officer Dave Miller \$35 per incident during the off season.
12. On a recommendation by the Ordinance Committee, consider approval to have the Borough Solicitor create an agreement between Mill Hall Brough and Tom Smith/Valley Hotel/Clint Smith to cover all costs associated with creating a noise ordinance.
13. On a recommendation by the Ordinance Committee, consider approval to have the Borough Solicitor change ordinances relating to Snow Removal fines and Grass/Weed Ordinance fines.

Snow Removal: § 21-404 Penalties. [Ord. 61, 12/16/1952; as added by Ord. 1994-1, 11/1/1994, § 4]

Any person who shall violate any provision of this Part shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine not less than ~~\$50~~ **\$100** and not exceeding \$300 and costs or, in default of payment thereof, shall be subject to imprisonment for a term not to exceed 30 days. Each day that a violation of this Part continues shall constitute a separate offense.

Grass/Weeds: § 10-104 Penalties. [Ord. 69, 6/4/1947, § 4; as amended by Ord. 184, 4/3/1990]

Any person who shall violate any provision of this Part 1 shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine not less than ~~\$25~~ **\$75** nor exceeding \$600 and costs, or in default of payment thereof, shall be subject to imprisonment for a term not to exceed 30 days. Each day that a violation of this Part continues shall constitute a separate offense. Notice to the offender shall not be necessary in order to constitute an offense.
