UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Pool Discussion.
 - a. Consider approval to move forward with the pool bid.
2. On a recommendation of the Sewer/Highway Committee, consider approval of ditch berming in the Borough using Pine Creek Township at an hourly rate of \$650 up to 8 hours. Approval to pay out of Liquid Fuels.
3. Discussion on Borough owned sidewalks. Consider approval to start the process of abandoning three alleys in the Borough. Consider approval to start working on the Borough owned sidewalks.
4. On a recommendation of the Sewer/Highway Committee, consider installation of fencing around grass area at Monument. Paid for out of the memorial fund.
